Parents are invited to join us at the Fingal Foreshore Park (on Marine Parade), with the Cross Country commencing around 9.30am.

We will need the help of a few parents to monitor the marker points along the cross country circuit. Please contact the school if you would be available to help out.

We will be organising fruit and water for the students for when they have completed the run!

The cross country distances are as follows:

- ♦ 5-7 years, 800m
- 8-9 years, 2 km
- 10 years, 2km
- 11 years, 3km
- 12-13 years, 3km

The age group the children will be running in relates to the age they will turn this year. The focus of the carnival is for every child to participate and give it their best. This might mean that some children will walk part of the course.

Students will need to wear suitable jogging shoes for the cross country carnival.

The students will be chosen based on time to progress to the District Cross Country being held on Friday, 17 May at Murwillumbah.
